

Facts and figures about EUROPEADA 2022

EUROPEADA is...

- the European Football Championship of the autochthonous national minorities.
- a major sporting event that combines fair competition and the excitement of a sports festival with the interests of the autochthonous national minorities.
- held every four years since 2008, in the same year as the UEFA EURO (this year is an exception due to the pandemic)
- at its 4th edition in Carinthia/Koroška
- was previously held in the following places: Graubünden/Switzerland (2008), Lausitz/Germany (2012), South Tyrol/Italy (2018).
- hosted by the Federal Union of European Nationalities (FUEN) and organised in cooperation with the host minority, in this case the Carinthian Slovenes. For this purpose, the association "Europeada - European Football Championship of Ethnic Groups" was founded with its headquarters in Klagenfurt.
- This year's motto is: "together unique / skupno enkratni / gemeinsam einzigartig".

The teams

- 23 teams, 19 men's and 4 women's teams
- From 11 European countries
- Around 550 participants from football delegations, around 750 in total
- Age range of the players: 15 to 53 years old

Venues

- 12 venues in total, 11 of them in the region of Carinthia/Austria, 1 in Slovenia (Prevalje)
